

Caboolture Photography Club Print Competition Rules 2023

The print competition is open to Members only.

The competition year for the print competition runs for the same time as the Digital Image Competition, January through to November inclusive.

For the first year of competition, prints do not have to be pre-registered, but will be registered by the Print Coordinator on the night of competition.

Prints must be submitted on the night of judging by 6.45 pm.

Each monthly competition will be OPEN category, meaning all genres of images may be entered, and either colour or monochrome.

Maximum mount size is 500 x 400 (or 20" x 16"), with a preference for A4 or similar print size.

All prints must be presented on a matt board, and labelled on the back in the bottom right hand corner with Entrant's Name and Image Title.

One print may be entered per participant.

Any internally awarded images, digital or print, cannot be re-entered into any club competition.

Scoring:

- 1 point Acceptance
- 2 points Commended
- 3 Points Highly Commended
- 4 Points Merit
- 5 points Honour

One print will be chosen by the attending judge as the print of the night. (Extra 5 points)

Each print of the month will go into the end of year competition to be judged for the print of the year.

Changes, Alterations or Adjustments to the rules

The committee reserves the right to make changes, alterations or adjustments to the rules of the Caboolture Photography Club Print Competition as the committee deems necessary. Notice can be given of a rule change, alteration or adjustment at any time prior to the end of the current project. Any changes, alterations or adjustments will come into effect at the completion of the current project and will be the rules for any future projects.
