

AAPS PSQA

SET: (S) Window and/or Doors.

A photograph where the primary subject consists of Windows and/or Doors. This could be a classical photograph of the door at the entry to a building or maybe decorated for Christmas. Old doors have lots of character. Like those from abandoned or historical buildings. Doors can be open or shut providing any composition options looking through the door. Windows similarly show character and often have reflections or provide the opportunity to peek within. No people allowed.
