This could be a classical photograph of the door at the entry to a building or maybe decorated for Christmas. Old doors have lots of character, like those from abandoned or historical buildings. Doors can be open or shut providing many composition options looking through the door. Windows similarly show character and often have reflections or provide the opportunity to peek within. | March                       | 26 Feb         | <b>Food Photography</b>                    | Food photography encompasses images where food is the main or prominent element within the frame. This genre allows for the inclusion of people engaging with the food, provided that their involvement contributes to conveying a narrative.   | 26 Mar       | Qld Interclub 2024  |
| April                       | 25 Mar         | <b>Architecture</b>                        | Pictures depicting the interior or exterior of any manmade structure portraying the surface texture, lighting, colour, or geometry and emphasising the character or beauty of the structure. | May                         | 22 Apr         | <b>Minimalism</b>                          | Less is More – use a minimal number of elements such as colour, shape, line, and texture to create a striking image.  | 28 May       |                     |
| June                        | 27 May         | <b>Technology</b>                          | Any form of technology. The Technology must be the star. Try to capture your impression of the theme in a creative or interesting way.  | 25 June      |                     |
| July                        | 24 June        | <b>Starts with the letter 'T'</b>          | An image of any object/person/thing whose title commences with the letter "T". Image may be mono or colour.   | 23 July      |                     |
